Leaving a legacy to the Whitehall Choir

Whilst nobody likes to think of the time when they are not longer here, a legacy to a charity can make a difference long after it is given. Please consider remembering Whitehall Choir in your will and the pleasure that its singing brings to many people, both performers and audience.

Residuary bequest

A gift of the remainder of the estate after all other bequests have been made and debts cleared is called a residuary bequest.

Example of will text for residuary bequest:

I give (%) of the residue of my real and personal estate which I can dispose of by Will in any manner I think proper to WHITEHALL CHOIR (Registered Charity No. 280478) of Whitehall Choir (Treasurer), c/o Department for Business, Information, and Skills, 1 Victoria Street, London SW1H 0ET and the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or the proper officer for the time being of Whitehall Choir shall be a complete discharge to my Executors.

Pecuniary bequest

A gift of a fixed sum of money in your Will is called a pecuniary bequest. The value of pecuniary legacies will decrease over time, as the cost of living increases.

Example of will text for pecuniary bequest:

I give the sum of [insert amount] pounds to Whitehall Choir (Registered Charity No. 240478) of Whitehall Choir (Treasurer), c/o Department for Business, Information, and Skills, 1 Victoria Street, London SW1H 0ET and the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of Whitehall Choir shall be a complete discharge to my Executors.
